Marilyn and I joined the CTTA in 2004 and I was appointed Chairman in 2007, so it is now time to retire and hand over the reins to someone younger. It would not have been possible to do this job for so long without the fantastic support from the rest of the committee but especially from Geoff who has been secretary for much, much longer. Very many thanks to them all.

The 20 years in the CTTA have been a most enjoyable and interesting experience not least due to the many friends we have made, not only in Dorsten but also here in Crawley.



However we will also never forget some of the great experiences we have had and the places we have visited.

On our first visit in 2004 it was to the Neanderthal museum near Köln, located in the Neander valley where the first remains of Neanderthal man were found. It brought pre-history to life and was a unique experience.

Another highlight was the visit to the Meyerwerft shipyard in Papenburg where within one large building we saw not one but two large cruise ships under construction. With the cabins being constructed as finished modular units off site and fitted into the ship like Lego blocks this enabled the total ship to be built in less than one year.
